# Bubbles

Want to treat yourself? Maybe start off with a cheeky cava or champagne (the Apollonis is perfect as aperitif). Or combine a bottle of the extraordinary Pierre Baillette with your favourite food.

## CAVA

**'Funambul Brut Nature' Penedès** 7.5 • 40  
**Azul Y Garanza - Xarel-Lo**

Bio cava with minimal sulphites. The grapes are biologically grown and fermentation is based on the traditional champagne method. Creamy and delicate, while maintaining some power and freshness. 11.5%

## CHAMPAGNE

**Brut 'Authentic Meunier'**  
**half • whole • magnum** 35 • 65 • 130  
**Apollonis - Pinot Meunier**

No big name, just great champagne. Want to boost your appetite? This is the one! An accessible champagne, rich in fruits, yet refreshing. The sweet-bitter flavour of grapefruit makes it a great appetiser. Sounds like a fairy-tale, right? It is. 12%

**Extra-Brut 'Le Village'** 75  
**Pierre Baillette - Pinot Noir, Chardonnay, Pinot Meunier**

Bio champagne and a real Beauty with a capital B. Aged on wood, giving it more structure and tannins. Fresh citrus and small white flowers, with tones of minerals and almonds. We like to serve it in a wineglass to do it justice. Premier en grand cru. 12%

## SWEET WINE

**Sauternes Bordeaux** 6.5 • 26  
**2017 Château Haut Bergeron - Semillon**

Not really bubbles of course, but this is also one you could start or end your meal with! A world famous dessert wine out of Bordeaux. Creamy, milky, heavenly sweet. Combine with a bite (or two, or three) of cheese or our desserts. 375 ml. 13%

## WHITE

**Verdejo - Rueda** 5.5 • 27.5

**2020 Telmo Rodriguez 'Basa'**

Passion fruit, melon, and a hint of vennel. 13%

**Palomino - Jerez** 7 • 35

**2021 Barbadillo 'Sábalo'**

A fresh wine with aromas of ripe apple and mineral notes in the scent. Easy on the cheeks. 13.5%

**Riesling - Mosel** 7.5 • 37.5

**2020 Weingut Regnery 'Kabinett Trocken'**

A fresh, typical Riesling with lots of citrus. 12%

**Pinot Grigio - Friuli** 8 • 40

**2020 Russolo 'Ronco Calaj'**

Not your average Pinot Grigio, deep tones of ripe fruit while keeping its freshness. 12.5%

**Chardonnay - Bourgogne** 9 • 48

**2019 Hervé Kerlann 'Hautes-Côtes des Nuits'**

A full wine balanced by fresh acidity. Mild spices (cinnamon, vanilla) and mirabelle plum. 14%

## RED

**Monastrell - Alicante** 5.5 • 27.5

**2020 Telmo Rodríguez 'Al-Muvedre'**

Dark blackberries combined with herbs. A ripe and warm taste, but still keeps its freshness. 14%

**Grenache, Syrah - Côtes-du-Rhône** 6.5 • 32.5

**2020 Les Vins de Vienne 'Les Cranilles'**

Flexible, juicy, and super ripe. 14%

**Tempranillo - Rioja** 7 • 34

**2018 Telmo Rodríguez 'Corriente'**

Lots of fruitiness, blackberries and vanilla. 14%

**Pinot Noir - Bourgogne** 9 • 48

**2019 Hervé Kerlann**

An elegant wine with tones of red fruit. 13%

**Barbera d'Asti - Piémonte** 9 • 48

**2017 Cascina Vèngore 'Mompirone'**

Tones of jam, blackberry, blueberry with some spicy notes and herbs. 14.5%

# White

## SPAIN

**'Davila' Rías Baixas** 42

**2021 Adegas Valminór - Albariño, Loureiro, Treixadura**

Adegas is internationally famous for his wines. White flowers, tropical fruit, a touch of salt. The minerals will race after you at the finish line. 12.5%

**'La Suertes' Rueda** 54

**2018 Nisia - Verdejo**

This is a full wine with perfumes of hay and white fruit, with a little bit of fattiness. Oak wood, apple, papaya: this complex wine will make you stop talking. 13.5%

**'Patinegro' Jerez** 41

**2020 Barbadillo - Palomino**

An organic wine, aged for 12 months in oak casks that previously held sherry. A bright gold colour, ripe fruit, nutty, and spicy notes. You might even recognise some sherry flavours. Curious why? Ask Bart. 13%

## ITALY

**'DOCG Gavi di Gavi' Piémonte** 36

**2020 Nicola Bergaglio - Cortese**

Again Piemonte? Yes, because we love wines from there. Biologic and hand-picked grapes. Golden yellow of colour with ripe fruit and citrus. Full bodied. 13%

**'DOC Etna Bianco' Sicily** 45

**2020 Tenuta Tornatore - Carricante**

White wines from Sicily are hotter than the volcano on which they're cultivated. Why? In the nose lots of peach and grapes mixed with some herbs. Minerals and spring freshness is what you get. 12.5%

## FRANCE

**'Pouilly Fumé' Loire** 47.5

**2019 Emmanuelle Mellot - Sauvignon Blanc**

What's not to love about a woman who makes great wine? Flowery aromas fly out of the glass. A stylish wine with citrus notes, white berries and pear. 13.5%

**'Sancerre Mont Damnès' Loire** 48.5

**2018 Pierre Martin - Sauvignon Blanc**

Sancerre, who doesn't want a wine from there? And this is in the heart of it all, Chavignol! Fresh, chalk, citrus, white flowers, almonds and great minerals. Go on and order. 13.5%

# White

**'Mâcon-Milly-Lamartine' Bourgogne 39**

**2018 Alexis Pollier - Chardonnay**

Alexis is a true wonder child: only 25 and making great wines. Summery blossoms, citrus, honey, nice minerals and still fresh. A chardonnay French style. 13%

**'Chablis Premier Cru' Bourgogne 62**

**2019 Julien Brocard - Chardonnay**

Julien only makes wine if nature allows him. A bio dynamic wine with explosive taste & perfume. A perfect balance between fruits and chalky minerals. 13.5%

**'Saint Romain' Bourgogne 66**

**2018 Pierre Henri Rougeot - Chardonnay**

Easy perfumes, easy acidity, elegant structure and a great balance between fruit, acidity and minerals. Yes, we are entering the premier league with this one. 13%

**'Meursault Clos des Meix Chavaux' Bourgogne**

**2018 Claudine Gaunoux - Chardonnay 78**

Claudine hates 'make-up wine': she doesn't need tricks in the aging process to cover up flaws in the taste. No wood for this lady. Excellent upkeep and branches with deep roots make this wine aromatic. Peach, nectarines and a hint of lemon. Long, flowery after taste. 13.5%

**'Chassagne-Montrachet' Bourgogne 85**

**2019 Bruno Collin - Chardonnay**

Intensity, fruitiness, expressiveness and generosity. A real powerhouse in the white wine league, in the best way possible. Please, a warm welcome to the yellow fruits like peach and apricot. 13.5%

**'Taburnum' Rhône 78**

**2018 Les Vins de Vienne - Viognier**

Long story short: Les Vins de Vienne are three top producers who combined their expertise to make this excellent wine. Ripe and exotic fruits, powerful start and a little bit of fattiness with a great balance. Chapeau. 14%

## GERMANY

**'Wachenheimer Böhlig P.C' Pfalz 65**

**2018/2020 Dr. Bürklin-Wolf - Riesling**

If you're into Riesling you have got to try this one: rich and full-bodied, yet elegant. Fresh citrus tones, minerality, great with fish. 13%

# Red

## SPAIN

**'Regina Viarum' Ribeira Sacra** 36

**2020 Regina Viarum - Mencia**

Wine that's made with respect for nature. Hand picked grapes which results in tastes of dark berries, mint and green herbs. Juicy and easy drinkable. We're just the messenger. 13.5%

**'Naturaleze Salvaje Tinto' Navarra** 42

**2020 Azul y Ganza - Garnacha**

A natural wine! We love it. Dark fruit, spices and leather. A complex and super interesting wine, without the additional extra sulphite. And still a beauty. True craftsmanship. 13%

**'Lanzaga' Rioja** 49

**2017 Telmo Rodríguez - Tempranillo**

This wine is a bit of a rebellious one. Figs, blue berries, prunes, vanilla and tobacco. Do you think of yourself as complex, elegant and chic? Then this is your wine. 14%

**'Viña Tondonia Reserva' Rioja** 68

**2010 R. López de Heredia - Tempranillo, Garnacha**

This is a special one! Aged for six year on oak casks. Elegance, structure, balance. Ripe black fruit, spices, leather, tobacco, balsamic, and ripe tannins. 13%

**'Pegaso Granito' Castilla y León** 65

**2014 Telmo Rodriguez - Garnacha**

Telmo and Pablo restored this abandoned winery. Result: a very rare and special wine with ripe berries, herbs and flowers. Juicy, with a lot of structure. 15%

## ITALY

**'DOCG Chianti Classico' Toscare** 55

**2017 Renzo Marinai - Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon**

What to say about this Chianti. Indeed, a Classico but the at the same time biologico. 10-12 months on wood, very powerful, with a seductive perfume and full body. 13.5%

**'Barbaresco Vie Erte' Piëmonte** 76

**2018 Cigliuiti - Nebbiolo**

This baby has been on wood for over 20 months. So, it has more than just cherries and floral tones. The tannins are nice but firm. Very long aftertaste. 14.5%

# Red

## FRANCE

### 'Saint-Émilion Grand Cru' *Bordeaux* 51

#### 2016 Chateau Queyron - Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Okay sit back and take this all in: berries, bay leaf, liquorice, tobacco. Complex, deep and with noticeable tannins. We will stop talking now so you can order.

### 'Côte de Nuits Villages' *Bourgogne* 62

#### 2018 Domaine Truchetet - Pinot Noir

A young new talent who works with his hands, made this special wine: red cherries, and with a warm start. And almost biological. Kudos for this one! We will let you be the judge of the finish. 13%

### 'Gevrey-Chambertin Aux Etelois' *Bourgogne*

#### 2017 Chateau de Laborde - Pinot Noir 82.5

Ruby red is this one. Thyme, saffron, turmeric and tones of dark, dark chocolate. A lot of volume and a long, long after taste. This is our best kept secret. We dare you. 13.5%

### 'Côtes du Rhône Rouge' *Rhône* 38

#### 2019 Domaine la Manarine - Grenache

This wine maker is called the 'Grenache whisperer'. Interested? Try this one with deep dark cherries and stove herbs in this warm bodied wine. 14%

### 'Crozes-Hermitage La Matinière' *Rhône* 41

#### 2018 Domaine Ferraton - Syrah

A Syrah as we like it: red cherries, black berries and raspberries, with a hint of black pepper. This round and flexible wine is our berry favourite, very favourite, my mistake. 13.5%

# Rosé

**'Pélous rosé Cévennes' Cévennes** 5 • 25

**2020 Philippe Nüsswitz - Cinsault**

Light salmon colour. Smells like lively red fruit. Crispy freshness and lively acidity. Philippe knows how to make a good one. 12.5%

**'Rosé des Pins' Bordeaux** 35

**2020 Haut Bergeron - Cabernet Sauvignon**

This rosé has had fermentation on oak wood barrels. If we tell you this one has a bouquet of rich citrus, white flowers and lychees, you'll order immediately, right? 12.5%

**'Inspiration Rosé' Provence** 39.5

**2020 Château de Berne - Grenache Noir, Cinsault, Syrah, Merlot**

A perfect example of Provence rosé. Fresh and expressive perfumes of strawberry, raspberry and lavender. Nice intense taste which is fresh and soft at the same time. 13%

**'Marsannay Rosé' Bourgogne** 43.5

**2018 Domaine Bart - Pinot Noir**

This is a special one, this rosé. Made of Pinot Noir grapes and firstly made by the grandfather of Bart (not Bart from Barrica, but we like to pretend). Fresh and tight acidity. This wine is at its best at 10-12 degrees. Gotta love it. 12.5%
