This wine has juicy, fresh fruit aromatics, with flavours of **honeydew melon**, guava and grapefruit zest. The **creamy texture** and rich flavours of **toasted oak** are framed by a bright and **fresh acidity** that lifts the fruit and leaves a lingering finish that will keep you wanting more...

#### **'Mayor's Choice'** *Priorat/Amsterdam* 51 2021 Chateau Amsterdam - Garnacha Not just anyone, but the Mayor's Choice. A Dutch wine! Wait? No? That can't be right? But yes it is! Well, the grapes are imported from Spain, but the wine is made, right here in Amsterdam. The wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks and then aged in French oak barrels for 6 months. And then you're left with a full-bodied red with notes of plums, cherries and spices. 13%

#### 'Phinca San Julian' Rioja 2019 Bodegas Bhilar - Tempranillo, Graciano, Viura I'm gonna say it, I'm just gonna say it: one of the best Rioja wines out there. Why? All the grapes are from a tiny plot on a steeply graded hill. The vineyard is kept cool and collected due to the limestone soils and the east-facing orientation. In the nose, we got blackberries, we got vanilla, we got spiciness. In the mouth, we got mild tannins, we got mild acidity, we got a long finish. And then I think we got a winner. 14%

#### 'Al-Muvedre' Alicante 2021 Telmo Rodriguez - Monastrell

The mona-what now? Monastrell! Yes, she is a little less known, but still worthy of your attention. A sultry scent with dark forest fruit and some earthy tones. Ripe and fresh in taste, with a somewhat spicy finish. The perfect companion for the Mediterranean kitchen. What a coincidence...13.5%

#### 'DOCG Amarone della Valpolicella' Veneto

2015 Emilio Fidora - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella Sit back for this story. It's worth it. Amarone is made by harvesting fully ripened grapes and leaving them to dry in wooden crates, Fruttaio, for up to five months. These wines are immensely full-bodied and rich, and absolutely delicious. Aged for a period of 42-50 months in big wooden barrels and about 12 months on bottle afterwards. Complex, rich wine with aromas of **plums**, with spicy notes and dried fruit with a powerful character. We won't hear from you for a while. 16%

**'DOC Valpolicella Ripasso'** *Veneto* 42 **2019 Emilio Fidora - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella** A second fermentation and 24 months in French oak? Yes please! A smooth, Italian wine is always the way to go. Lightly perfumed wine with aromas of **red fruit, ripe and dried cherry, and some spices**. Full and smooth in the mouth, with a balanced finish where you recognise that characteristically Italian bitter aftertaste. 14%

#### 'Belgardo' *Terre Alfieri* 2019 Cascina Vengore - Nebbiolo

Nebbiolo... now why does that sound familiar? Ah, yes, you may know this grape from the famous Barolo and Barbaresco (find the latter one also on our menu!). One theory is that Nebbiolo comes from the Italian word for fog, 'nebbia', referring to the white, powder-like veil on the grapes during harvest season. This Nebbiolo is a spicy one with **cinnamon**, but with some **juicy berry** and **ripe cherry** flavours. And what's that in the background? Some **dark chocolate**. It has rested in Slovenian oak barrels for 16 months. Resulting in an elegant, fresh wine. 13.5%

**DOCG Chianti Classico**'*Toscane* 9.5/47.5 **2019 Renzo Marinai - Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon** Who doesn't know the chianti classico? Intense flavours, beautifully structured, with a delicate and lingering perfume. A beauty with a **full body, dry** and packed with flavour: **dark fruit, herbs, and sage**. Aged for around a year in oak barrels. 13.5%

#### **DOCG Chianti Classico Gran Selezione**' *Tuscany* **79** 2018 Renzo Marinai - Sangiovese

Wait, is this the same one as the one before? Yes, but also no. See, it's the same house and the same grape, but just a little better. That's what the 'Gran Selezione' stands for. Only the very best grapes and new techniques. And compared to the previous one, longer aging (9 months in large barrels, 18 months in barriques). Delicate, elegant, balanced and with **remarkable body**. A stand-out character, persistence and **power**. High in tannins, ripe fruit, **plum**, with **earthy and rustic aromas**. Please let it breath. 14%

#### 'Barbaresco Vie Erte' *Piëmonte* 2019 Cigliuiti - Nebbiolo

This baby has been on **wood for over 20 months**. So, it has **more than just cherries and floral tones**. The tannins are nice but firm. Very **long aftertaste**. 14.5%

'Côte-de-Nuits Villages' Bourgogne 76 2019 Domaine Truchetet - Pinot Noir A young new talent who works with his hands made this special wine: red cherries, and with a warm start. And almost biological. Truly one of Barrica's favourites. 13%

The Syrah adds dark berries and black pepper. And the Mourvèdre rounds it all up with smoky, savoury flavours. It's the best of both worlds, I mean, three worlds. Either way, a great wine. 14%

#### 'Crozes-Hermitage La Matinière' Rhône 2021 Domaine Ferraton - Syrah

Single vineyard cuvée, classically made and aged in large barrels, making the tannins super soft. A Syrah the way we like it: red cherries, black berries and raspberries, with a pinch of freshly ground black pepper. This round and flexible wine is our berry favourite, sorry, very favourite, my mistake. 13.5%

'Saint-Émilion Grand Cru' Bordeaux 2016 Chateau Queyron - Merlot, Cabernet Franc Classic style Saint Emillion, with dark fruits and plumbs, tobacco and leather notes. 2016 already had quite a bit of bottle aging, so the tannins are slightly reduced and the secondary notes are starting to come through the fruit layer. \*Hic\* okay, last one, \*hic\*, I swear. The first scent you'll notice in this Pinot Noir is fresh red fruit, which will be followed by red berries and sour cherries. Freshness due to the height of the vineyard, but **body** due to the southern location of the vineyard. 13%
