2022 Pares Balta - Xarel-Lo & Gewuztraminer

Pares Balta is a winery that dates back to the 18th century, and they work with exclusively organic and biodynamic farming practices. This one is an easy to drink, slightly cloudy orange wine. With notes of **white fruit, blossoms and white flowers**. Fine tannins, fresh and a finish **full of flavour**. 12.5%

2015 Chateau Haut Bergeron - Semillon

A world-famous sweet wine from the Bordeaux and the only Sauternes made on an island (in the Ciron River). On the one hand, a lot of botrytis (wine lovers: you know this is strange and yet so interesting), which provides the sweetness. On the other hand, light **freshness** due to the rich terroir. **Creamy, milky, heavenly sweet**. Combine with a bite (or two, or three) of cheese or our desserts. 13%

'Kabinett Trocken' Mosel 8 / 40

2021 Weingut Regnery - Riesling

Ask our bartender Christian to recommend you a wine, and he will almost always say this one. Okay, always. A fresh, typical Riesling with **lots of citrus**, but well **balanced with fruit tones**. Honestly, just a beauty in its kind, we can't blame Koen for advertising this one. 12%

SPAIN

'Davila' Rías Baixas 43

2022 Adegas Valminór - Albariño, Loureiro, Treixadura

Adegas is internationally famous for his wines, exemplified by this beauty. A yellow golden liquid, aromatically intense and complex. **White flowers, tropical fruit**, a touch of salt, and even some aromatic herbs. The **minerals** will race after you at the finish line. 12.5%

'La Suertes' Rueda 54

2022 Nisia - Verdejo

This is a full wine with perfumes of hay and white fruit, with a little bit of fattiness. **Oak wood, apple, papaya**: this complex wine will make you stop talking. 13.5%

'Suañé Bianco' Rioja 65.5

2017 Alonso & Pedrajo - Viura, Sauvignon Blanc

A Spanish wine with a French connection: Suañé comes from the French 'soigné', which means **refined**. This refined beauty enjoyed 12 months in French **oak barrels**. **Florals, ripe white fruit, citrus**; fresh and vibrant. 13%

'Basa' Rueda 5.8 / 29

2022 Telmo Rodriguez - Verdejo

At first glance maybe 'just a verdejo', but make no mistake, this one is excellent in its simplicity. Higher in acidity, balanced with notes of **pear, melon and a hint of minerality**. Easy-going, juicy, and fresh. Just.Love.It. 13%

'Sábalo' Jerez 7.2 / 36

2021 Barbadillo - Palomino

This one got a 9- in 'De Grote Hamersma' and with good reason! Maybe you can detect the sherry grape in the scent, but the taste is beautifully balanced, with **ripe apple**, a soft **touch of acidity** and a **silty** aftertaste. Mon Sherry, here we come! 13%

'Ronco Calaj' Friuli 8.2 / 41

2022 Russolo - Pinot Grigio

Pinot Grigio boring? Not this one! The Pinot Grigio from Friuli is the best you can get. First you smell tones **ripe fruit and passion fruit**. And if you really try, some sage. A **lively, fresh, and friendly taste**. A real thirst-quencher. 12.5%

'Pieve Vecchia' Veneto 48

2020 Fasoli Gino - Garganega

You know a wine will be special when the grapes are picked at three different stages: just ripe, full ripe and overripe. Complex aroma's of **sweet oriental spices**, balanced by the fruity tones of **apple, peach, and some lime**. Round, full and soft taste. And all of that from a fully **organic** winery?! Yeah, we think it's best if you just try this one. 15%

'DOCG Gavi di Gavi' Piemonte 38.5

2023 Nicola Bergaglio - Cortese

Piemonte should make you think of the red wines Barolo and Barbaresco. But surprise! The Gavi di Gavi is an **organic** white wine with hand-picked grapes. Really. Golden yellow of colour with **ripe fruit**, apple and crispy lime. **Full bodied and dry**. 13%

'Lulu' Carassai 7.6 / 38

2021 Dianetti Vini - Passerina

These grapes are harvested y hand in the early mornings, immediately taken to the cellar and crushed. Leaving you with a special, **crisp** wine. **Floral notes** and a tasty aroma at the service of a cheerful drinking experience in the glass.

'Vignagiulia' Carassai 55.5

2021 Dianetti Vini - Pecorino

Full and refined. Its **full-body mouth-feel** and a properly brisk texture make it a dynamic wine with a **deep and salty finish**.

FRANCE

'Les Terres Turones' Loire 8.5 / 42.5

2020 Dominique & Philippe - Chenin Blanc

If I say Chenin Blanc, you say...? Exactly: **higher in acidity, fresh, dry**, somewhat reminiscent of a Sauvignon Blanc. This one has some **fruity tones** in the smell and notes of ripe pear and spices in the taste. A light wine but with a great personality. Just like us (can we say that? I guess so). 14%

‘Pouilly Fumé’ Loire 52

2022 Emmanuelle Mellot - Sauvignon Blanc

What's not to love about a woman who makes great wine? **Flowery aromas** fly just out of the glass. A stylish wine with **citrus notes, white berries and pear**. 13.5%

‘Sancerre Chavignol’ Loire 45

2022 Pierre Martin - Sauvignon Blanc

Sancerre, who doesn't want a wine from there? This is in the heart of it all, Chavignol! **Fresh, chalk, citrus**, white flowers, almonds and great minerals. Go on and order. 13.5%

‘Saint Veran’ Bourgogne 43.5

2022 Alexis Pollier - Chardonnay

Alexis is a true wonder child, the prodigy winemaker from the ‘Cote Maconnaise’. **Biodynamically** maintained vineyards for optimal health and ripeness of these grapes. Partly aged on wood. And all of that comes together in this beautiful chardonnay *French style*: exceptionally **fresh with citrus notes, summery blossoms**, and a small layer of **honey** on top. 13%

‘Saint Romain’ Bourgogne 75

2020 Pierre Henri Rougeot - Chardonnay

Vin Naturel from the village of Saint Romain, located a little higher on the Cote than the famous Mersault. This wine is made in small quantities. It may not have the allure of the Mersault, but certainly has the same style. Easy perfumes, easy acidity, **elegant** structure and a **great balance between fruit, acidity and minerals**. Yes, we are entering the premier league with this one. 13%

‘Intensément’ Bourgogne 9.7 / 49.5

2022 Baudouin Millet - Chablis (Chardonnay)

Are you someone who ‘doesn’t like Chardonnay’? Let this Chablis prove you wrong. A great wine from little Baudouin. Fully vinified and matured in **stainless steel**, classic Chablis with **citrus fruit** and an **almost salty aftertaste** where you feel a **chalk** line being drawn across your tongue, so to speak. Worth a try! 13%

WHITE

FRANCE

'Bourgogne Blanc' *Bourgogne* 51

2020 Morgan Truchetet - Chardonnay

One of the big talents of the Bourgogne! They make fantastic wines from (very) old vines. Try to smell the **white fruits**, with some lifting **green notes**. Then taste the soft, **supple buttery palate**, with little acidity at the end, and a long, creamy finish. 13%

'Le Grand Courtil' *Rhône* 76

2020 Ferraton Crozes-Ermitage - Marsanne, Roussanne

Great wine from a mid-slope plot, clay-limestone at the bottom, granite and gravel at the top. At first scent you'll experience some **yellow fruit**, followed by **almonds and roasted chestnuts** due to the fermentation in oak barrels. A **full and round** wine. Definitely a treat! 12%

'Taburnum' *Rhône* 86

2021 Les Vins de Vienne - Viognier

Abandoned vineyards. They exist. We can't understand why. And Les Vins de Vienne, the three top producers who combined their expertise to make this excellent wine on ancient grounds, didn't understand either. They made this pearl of **ripe and exotic fruits, wood**, a powerful start and a **little bit of fattiness** with a great balance. Chapeau! You won't regret this one. 14%

'Vin Libre' *Juraçon, Pyrenees* 41

2021 Domaine Montesquiou - Gros & Petit Manseng

From the Pyrenees, where the hot and dry climate allows it to work almost completely naturally (only a little bit of sulphite added at bottling to stabilize the wine for export). Pour your glass full with **tropical fruit** and the **widest acidity** you can find in a wine. 13%

U.S.A.

'Sonoma Coast Chardonnay' *Sonoma County* 11 / 55

2020 Reata Winery - Chardonnay

U.S.A! Chardonnay! The only wine on our list from overseas, but for good reason! Award-winning winemaker Linda Trotta focusses on Chardonnay and Pinot Noir from the best vineyards on the California coasts, where the sun, sea and soil work great together. This wine has juicy, fresh fruit aromatics, with flavours of **honeydew melon**, guava and grapefruit zest. The **creamy texture** and rich flavours of **toasted oak** are framed by a bright and **fresh acidity** that lifts the fruit and leaves a lingering finish that will keep you wanting more...

RED

NETHERLANDS

'Mayor's Choice' Priorat/Amsterdam 51

2022 Chateau Amsterdam - Garnacha

Not just anyone, but the Mayor's Choice. A Dutch wine! Wait? No? That can't be right? But yes it is! Well, the grapes are imported from Spain, but the wine is made, right here in Amsterdam. The wine is fermented in stainless steel tanks and then aged in French oak barrels for 6 months. And then you're left with a **full-bodied red with notes of plums, cherries and spices**. 13%

SPAIN

'Naturaleze Salvaje Tinto' Navarra 43

2021 Azul y Garanza - Garnacha

A **natural** wine! We love it. **Dark fruit, spices and leather**. A complex and super interesting wine, without the additional extra sulphite. And still a beauty. True craftsmanship. 13%

'Lanzaga' Rioja 52

2020 Telmo Rodríguez - Tempranillo

This wine is a bit of a rebellious one and we love that. **Figs, blue berries, prunes, vanilla and tobacco**. Do you think of yourself as complex, elegant and chic? Then this is your wine. 14%

'Viña Tondonia Reserva' Rioja (half/whole) 35 / 68

2011 R. López de Heredia - Tempranillo, Garnacha

This is a special one: the region, the bodegas, the legend. Lopez de Heredia steers its own course and ages the wines for a very long time (we're talking years!) both in oak casks and bottles, until they feel they are ready to drink. Elegance, structure, balance. **Ripe black fruit, spices, leather, tobacco, balsamic, and ripe tannins**. Let this one breath first! 13%

'Suañé Tinto' Rioja 59

2017 Alonso & Pedrajo - Tempranillo

A tempranillo from the Rioja region... again? Yes! But trust us, also worth a try: with nice intense aromas on the nose of both **red fruit and spicy notes**. But soft and pleasant in the taste. Nicely **integrated tannins**, easy to drink, with a long aftertaste. But this one does like a little breather, so get yourself another drink while this one takes around 30 minutes to get ready for you. 14.5%

RED

SPAIN

'Corriente' *Rioja* 7.2 / 36

2021 Telmo Rodriguez - Tempranillo

Yooheoo! We got another great one for you! And like always, Telmo doesn't play around with artificial fertilizers and poison on the vineyard. In the nose, we got **blackberries**, we got **vanilla**, we got spiciness. In the mouth, we got mild tannins, we got **mild acidity**, we got a **long finish**. And then I think we got a winner. 14%

'Al-Muvedre' *Alicante* 5.5 / 27.5

2022 Telmo Rodriguez - Monastrell

The mona-what now? Yes, she is a little less known, but still worthy of your attention. A sultry scent with **dark forest fruit and some earthy tones**. Ripe and **fresh** in taste, with a somewhat spicy finish. The perfect companion for the Mediterranean kitchen. 13.5%

ITALY

'DOCG Amarone della Valpolicella' *Veneto* 71

2015 Emilio Fidora - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella

Amarone is made by harvesting fully ripened grapes and leaving them to dry in wooden crates, *Fruttaio*, for up to five months. These wines are immensely **full-bodied and rich**, and absolutely delicious. Aged for a period of 42-50 months in big wooden barrels and about 12 months on bottle afterwards. Complex, rich wine with aromas of **plums**, with **spicy notes** and **dried fruit** with a powerful character. 16%

'DOC Valpolicella Ripasso' *Veneto* 42

2019 Emilio Fidora - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella

A second fermentation and 24 months in French oak? Yes please! A smooth, Italian wine is always the way to go. Lightly perfumed wine with aromas of **red fruit, ripe and dried cherry, and some spices**. Full and smooth in the mouth, with a balanced finish where you recognise that characteristically Italian bitter aftertaste. 14%

'Barbaresco Vie Erte' *Piemonte* 79

2019 Cigliuiti - Nebbiolo

These grapes grow on a sandy soil, rich in lime, which facilitates a higher acidity. The vineyards have a south-west orientation, with sun until late in the day. The relatively young vines provide a light, elegant character, dominated by juicy fruit. Aged **for over 20 months on wood** for complexity, so you get hints of tobacco and tar, but these are nicely balanced by flavours of **cherries and floral tones**. The tannins and acidity are nice and firm. Very **long aftertaste**. 14.5%

2020 Cascina Vengore - Nebbiolo

Nebbiolo... novew why does that sound familiar? Ah, yes, you may know this grape from the famous Barolo and Barbaresco (find the latter one also on our menu!). One theory is that Nebbiolo comes from the Italian word for fog, 'nebbia', referring to the white, powder-like veil on the grapes during harvest season. This Nebbiolo is a spicy one with **cinnamon**, but with some **juicy berry** and **ripe cherry** flavours. And what's that in the background? Some **dark chocolate**. It has rested in Slovenian oak barrels for 16 months. Resulting in an elegant, fresh wine. 13.5%

'I Commedianti' *Cortona, Toscare*

2019 I Commedianti - Sangiovese, Merlot

This one is technically a local wine, as it's from our neighbour Henk Veltkamp. An affordable Sangiovese, blended with Merlot, that holds up! Notes of **red and dark fruit, prominent tannins, high in acidity**. 13%

'DOCG Chianti Classico' *Toscane*

2019 Renzo Marinai - Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon

Who doesn't know the chianti classico? Intense flavours, beautifully structured, with a delicate and lingering perfume. A beauty with a **full body, dry** and packed with flavour: **dark fruit, herbs, and sage**. Aged for around a year in oak barrels. 13.5%

'DOCG Chianti Classico Gran Selezione' *Tuscany* 79

2019 Renzo Marinai - Sangiovese

Wait, is this the same one as the one before? Yes, but also no. See, it's the same house and the same grape, but just a little better. That's what the 'Gran Selezione' stands for. Only the very best grapes and new techniques. And compared to the previous one, longer aging (9 months in large barrels, 18 months in barriques). Delicate, elegant, balanced and with **remarkable body**. A stand-out character, persistence and **power**. High in tannins, ripe fruit, **plum**, with **earthy and rustic aromas**. Please let it breath. 14%

'Hervée Kerlann Pinot Noir' - Bourgogne 48
2021 Chateau de Laborde - Pinot Noir

Ooh, la, la! A pinot noir! An elegant, light wine with tones of **red fruit, bright acidity and silky tannins**.

But wait, what's that? Do I detect some black cherry? Even some oriental spices? All I know is that it tastes good. 13%

'Côte-de-Nuits Villages' Bourgogne 76
2020 Domaine Truchetet - Pinot Noir

A young new talent who works with his hands made this special wine: **red cherries, and with a warm start**. And almost biological. Truly one of Barrica's favourites. 13%

'Côtes-du-Rhône Villages Plan de Dieu' Rhône 8 / 40
2021 Domaine Ferraton - Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre

Ah, the *GSM* blend, a classic from the Rhône area. The Grenache offer rich, **red fruit flavours**. The Syrah adds **dark berries and black pepper**. And the Mourvèdre rounds it all up with **smoky, savoury flavours**. It's the best of both worlds, I mean, three worlds. Either way, a great wine. 14%

'Crozes-Hermitage La Matinière' Rhône 9 / 45
2021 Domaine Ferraton - Syrah

Single vineyard cuvée, classically made and aged in large barrels, making the **tannins super soft**. A Syrah the way we like it: **red cherries, black berries and raspberries**, with a pinch of freshly ground **black pepper**. This round and flexible wine is our berry favourite, sorry, very favourite, my mistake. 13.5%

'Saint-Émilion Grand Cru' Bordeaux 54
2016 Chateau Queyron - Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Classic style Saint Emillion, with **dark fruits and plumbs, tobacco and leather notes**. 2016 already had quite a bit of bottle aging, so the tannins are slightly reduced and the secondary notes are starting to come through the fruit layer. We call this comfort wine *pur sang*. 13.5%

'Hautes Pistes' Pays d'Oc 6.9 / 35
2022 Aubert & Mathieu - Pinot Noir

Hic okay, last one, **hic**, I swear. The first scent you'll notice in this Pinot Noir is fresh **red fruit**, which will be followed by **red berries and sour cherries**. **Freshness** due to the height of the vineyard, but **body** due to the southern location of the vineyard. 13%
