Our wine list is a bit... different. In the best way. It's personal, handpicked, and filled with bottles that tell stories—some from Catalunya (*our soft spot*), others from across the old world, thanks to our trusted Amsterdam-based wine whisperers.

You'll also find natural wines here - but not the overly funky kind. Think character, craftsmanship, and just the right amount of adventure. Whether you're here for a casual glass or a bottle for the table (*good call!*), you're in for something special.

Bart has tasted every single wine on this list (*someone had to do it*), and only the most soulful, surprising, or downright delicious made the cut. And because not every wine comes with an easy-to-pronounce name, we've added a little twist of our own. Let us introduce you to 'The Show Stopper', 'The Valley of Fear', and 'The Not-So-Humble One'.

So go ahead—ask questions, take a leap, try something new. This list was made to be explored. Cheers!

# Wine 101: Outsmart your table guests in just 3 minutes

Want to be armed with just enough 'wine wisdom' to fake your way through a tasting, or impress your table guests? Well, we've got you! Read this (or keep it close so you can cheat - we won't sell you out ;)

Cheers to looking smart and sipping smarter!

- **Sur Lie**: Fancy French for "on the lees." Translation: the wine gets cozy with its dead yeast cells for a while. Sounds gross, but it adds flavor, trust us. Think creamy, nutty vibes.
- **Aging**: Letting wine take a nap in barrels, tanks, or bottles so it matures. Younger wines are bold and loud; older wines are smooth and wise.
- Natural Wine: Made with less or no additives and móre personality, because of the no-filtering ánd clarification. Often cloudy, funky, and a bit wild—but def not all at Barrica and Bar UYT - we only select the best ones.
- **Aging on Wood**: Aging wine in barrels adds flavors like vanilla, spice, and toast. Basically, a luxury spa treatment.
- **Aging in Concrete Tanks**: Wine's hipster habitat. Adds minerality *without* oak flavors, and it's great for showing off the wine's raw, natural character.
- **Foudre**: A big wooden barrel (think XXL). It gives wine a gentler oak influence compared to smaller barrels.
- Fermentation: Yeast eats sugar, turns it into alcohol, and voilà—wine happens.
- **Tannins**: The reason your mouth feels dry after a sip of red wine. They add structure and aging potential.
- 'New world / Old world wines': New World (like the U.S., Australia) = bold, fruity wines. Old World (Europe) = elegant, earthy classics.
- **Chambring**: Fancy way of saying "let the wine warm up a bit." No one likes an ice-cold red.
- **Decanting**: Pouring wine into a decanter to let it breathe. Helps flavors open up, especially with older reds. It's like stretching before a big run.
- **Maceration**: Or 'Brisat' in Catalan. Leaving grape skins to chill with the juice. For reds, this is where the color and tannins come from.
- **Clarification**: removes matter using egg white (think: bacteria, dead yeast cells, tannines, proteins).
- **Brut Nature**: The driest of the dry if it comes to sparkling wine. No sugar added, no yeast added.

This one is made from Malvasia—a grape as rare as it is tricky to cultivate. After 9 months of serious *chilling* on the lees, it is pale gold in color, has floral aromas that draw you in and keep you hooked. What makes it special? The acidity. Bright, clean, and perfectly balanced, it adds an unexpected twist, with notes of passion fruit in every sip. 13%

#### 'The Quiet Rebel'

#### 2018 Pardas – Macabeu

A bold experiment in true Pardas style—Crida Verd dares to let a blending grape take center stage. This 100% Macabeu reveals surprising character and elegance on its own. The quiet rebel of the cellar. 12%

#### 'Davila' Rías Baixas

2022 Adegas Valminór - Albariño, Loureiro, Treixadura

Adegas is internationally famous for his wines. A yellow golden liquid, aromatically intense and complex. White flowers, tropical fruit, a touch of salt, and even some aromatic herbs. The minerals will race after you at the finish line. 12.5%

No fancy name needed here—just pure *Xarel·lo grape* from the oldest vineyards of Pardas: they strongly believe in the power of this grape. What they say about these old vineyards: 'they have more roots than leaves and more clay and limestone than grapes'. Aged in French oak and concrete, it's fresh: zesty citrus and crisp green apple meets a touch of vanilla, with notes of toast, white flowers, and light minerality that might remind you of a beautifully oaked Albariño. 12.5%

#### **'Rupestris'** *Penedès, Catalonia 'The loved one'*

**2023 Pardas – Xarel-lo** (Tsja~<u>rel</u>~lo), **Malvasia de Sitges** This is not a wine that shouts for attention—it doesn't need to. It's easy going, unpretentious, and proud of exactly what it is. The kind that everyone likes. But be aware: it's so charming, the bottle might be empty before you've even finished your glass. The concrete keeps it fresh and lively, while the barrels add a creamy depth and a long, satisfying finish. The result? A perfect balance between freshness and richness, with notes of ripe white fruits. This is a wine with stories to tell and layers to discover. Ready to dive in? 13.5%

Fully vinified and matured in stainless steel, classic Chablis with citrus fruit and an almost salty aftertaste where you feel a chalk line being drawn across your tongue, so to speak. Worth a try! 13%

#### **'Saint Romain'** *Bourgogne* **2022 Au Bas de Poillange - Chardonnay**

Vin Naturel from the village of Saint Romain, located a little higher on the Cote than the famous Mersault. Made by Morgan and Pauline Truchtet. This one has a great balance between fruit, acidity and minerals. Yes, we are entering the premier league with this one. 13%

#### 'Saint Veran' Bourgogne 2023 Alexis Pollier - Chardonnay

Alexis is a true wonder child, the prodigy winemaker from the 'Cote Maconnaise'. Biodynamically maintained vineyards for optimal health and ripeness of these grapes. Partly aged on wood. And all of that comes together in this beautiful chardonnay *French style:* exceptionally fresh with citrus notes, summery blossoms, and a small layer of honey on top. 13%

#### 'Sancerre Chavignol' Loire

#### 2022 Pierre Martin - Sauvignon Blanc

Sancerre, who doesn't want a wine from there? This is in the heart of it all, Chavignol! Fresh, chalk, citrus, white flowers, almonds and great minerals. Go on and order. 13.5%

#### 'Taburnum' Rhône

#### 2021 Les Vins de Vienne - Viognier

Abandoned vineyards. They exist. We don't understand why. And Les Vins de Vienne, the three top producers who combined their expertise to make this excellent wine on ancient grounds, didn't understand either. They made this pearl of ripe and exotic fruits, wood, a powerful start and a little bit of fattiness with a great balance. Chapeau! You won't regret this one. 14%

2023 Frisach – Garnacha Tinto, Cariñena

A blend of Garnacha and Carignan that's got just the right mix of character and charm. The secret? Maceration! (Fancy word, but stay with us): a technique where grape skins soak in the juice, in cool concrete tanks, adding color, soft tannins, and a little magic. The result? A wine that's fresh and lively, but with just enough body to keep you coming back for more. Ideal to kick off your evening, and gets this dinner party started! PS: during summer, we pop this beauty in the fridge. 13.5%

'L'Anit' Terra Alta, Catalonia 'The Not-So-Humble One' 2022 Frisach – Cariñena

This one is not humble, as you can see, and it's not even apologising for it. Well, it's got good reasons. Crafted from the Cariñena grape and aged for 9 months in concrete (no wood here), L'Anit is as pure as it gets. The result? A complex nose with spicy hints and a subtle, almost iron-like edge that grabs your attention. Powerful yet approachable, seductive tannins and bold, fruity flavors. Sourced from vines over 80 years old, this is the winemaker's pièce de résistance—an absolute top wine. (So, okay, not so humble for a reason). 13.0%

#### 'Aspriu (Tinto)' Penedès, Catalonia 'The Show Stopper'

#### 2015 Pardas – Cabernet Franc

100% handpicked Cabernet Franc grapes, aged in French oak barrels, and only 1.676 bottles made—yes, it's that special. This 2015 vintage has earned a Parker rating of 94/100 (not too shabby, right?), and one sip tells you why. It bursts with intense black fruit flavors-think blackberry, blueberry, and blackcurrant-layered with hints of leather, smooth vanilla, and a subtle kick of pepper. Full-bodied. If you're looking for a show stopper, this is it. But don't wait too long-these babies will be gone soon. 14.0%

#### 'Collita Roja' Penedès, Catalonia

'The Take-a-Deep-Breath'

#### 2018 Pardas – Sumoll

Important message: this one needs to breathe before unlocking its potential. With its predecessor (2017) scoring 94 point by Robert Parker, now the 2018 is released. 'The Elixir of Life'

#### 2022 Frisach – Garnacha Tinto, Garnacha Peluda, Garnacha Blanco, Cariñena

This beauty is a blend of the three Garnachas, made from vines that have seen over 65 years of sun, wind, and soil. The journey? A winter's rest in concrete tanks followed by 12 months à foudre (=a massive wooden mega-tank). Expect a refined and perfectly balanced wine with a touch of spice, and a burst of fresh red fruit. The finish? Oh, it's *long*—the kind that keeps you thinking about the next sip before you've even finished the first. Oh-so-satisfying: this one's a must-try. 14.0%

#### 'Sus Scrofa' Penedès, Catalonia

'The Wild Boar'

#### 2022 Pardas – Sumoll

Named after the wild boars that run around like crazzzyy in this region, *Sus Scrofa* is a true reflection of its Catalan roots. Made from the native Sumoll grape—an under-the-radar variety that this winemaker has mastered like no other. Okay, we are on thin ice here, but we think: this one is somewhere between Pinot Noir and Nebbiolo: ripe red fruit, light on it's feet, yet layered with just enough complexity to keep you guessing. With no oak to distract, the *Sumoll* shines through in its purest form. 12.5%

#### **'Vall Por'** *Priorat, Catalonia* 'The Valley of Fear'

#### 2022 Sangeníse i vaqué – Cariñena, Garnacha Tinto

Okay, the name comes from the valley where it's made in. But we have actual Fear of Running Out of this wine...And once you've tasted it, you'll understand! This 2022 beauty is a true GEM—a stunning combination of Cariñena and Garnacha grapes, aged for 12 months in both French and American oak barrels. Rich black fruit flavors *smashed* into notes of old leather, bold, but with a perfect balance between power and finesse, and the depth of barrel aging in every sip. Don't wait too long to order this one: you might really miss out. 15.0%

#### 2023 Telmo Rodriguez - Tempranillo

Yoohooo! We got another great one for you. And like always, winemaker Telmo doesn't play around with artificial fertilizers and poison on the vineyard. In the nose, we got blackberries, we got vanilla, we got spiciness. In the mouth, we got mild tannins, we got mild acidity, we got a long finish. And then I think we got a winner, 14%

#### 'Hautes-Côtes de Baune' Bourgogne **2022** Domaine Florence Cholet - Pinot Noir

This one no joke: it's seriously good. With a light ruby color and elegant aromas, a well structured palate, aged for 8 months in barrels with new oak, this one demands respect. 13%

#### 'Crozes-Hermitage La Matinière' Rhône 2021 Domaine Ferraton - Syrah

Single vineyard cuvée, classically made and aged in large barrels, making the tannins super soft. A Syrah the way we like it: red cherries, black berries and raspberries, with a pinch of freshly ground black pepper. This round and flexible wine is our berry favourite, sorry, very favourite, my mistake. 13.5%

#### 'Hautes Pistes' Pays d'Oc

#### 2023 Aubert & Mathieu - Pinot Noir

The first scent you'll notice in this Pinot Noir is fresh red fruit, which will be followed by red berries and sour cherries. Freshness due to the height of the vineyard, but body due to the southern location of the vineyard. 13%

#### 'Saint-Émilion Grand Cru' Bordeaux 2018 Chateau Haut Ferrandat - Merlot, Cabernet Franc

Classic style Saint Emillion, with dark fruits and plumbs, tobacco and leather notes. 2018 already had quite a bit of bottle aging, so the tannins are slightly reduced and the secondary notes are starting to come through the fruit layer. We call this comfort wine pur sang. 13.5%

#### 'LaManarine' Côtes du Rhône

#### 2022 Domaine la Manarine - Grenache

Bart's favourite! Well, one of them at least. The winemaker Gilles Casq has a strong preference for Grenache and you can taste that in this wine. A deep scent and colour with sultry fruit. Blackcurrant, nicely complemented by notes of flowers and spices. Full of flavour so take your time.14%

#### 'Belgardo' Terre Alfieri 2021 Cascina Vengore - Nebbiolo

Nebbiolo... now why does that sound familiar? Ah, yes, you may know this grape from the famous Barolo and Barbaresco (find the latter one also on our menu!). One theory is that Nebbiolo comes from the Italian word for fog, 'nebbia', referring to the white, powder-like veil on the grapes during harvest season. This Nebbiolo is a spicy one with cinnamon, but with some juicy berry and ripe cherry flavours. And what's that in the background? Some dark chocolate. It has rested in Slovenian oak barrels for 16 months. Resulting in an elegant, fresh wine. 13.5%

#### **'DOCG Amarone della Valpolicella'** *Veneto* 2015 Emilio Fidora - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella

Amarone is made by harvesting fully ripened grapes and leaving them to dry in wooden crates, *Fruttaio*, for up to five months. These wines are immensely full-bodied and rich, and absolutely delicious. Aged for a period of 42-50 months in big wooden barrels and about 12 months on bottle afterwards. Complex, rich wine with aromas of plums, with spicy notes and dried fruit with a powerful character. 16%

#### **'DOC Valpolicella Ripasso'** Veneto

2020 Emilio Fidora - Corvina, Corvinone, Rondinella

A second fermentation and 24 months in French oak? Yes please! A smooth, Italian wine is always the way to go. Lightly perfumed wine with aromas of red fruit, ripe and dried cherry, and some spices. Full and smooth in the mouth, with a balanced finish where you recognise that characteristically Italian bitter aftertaste. 14%

#### 'DOCG Chianti Classico' Toscane

2020 Renzo Marinai – Sangiovese, Cabernet Sauvignon

Who doesn't know the chianti classico? Intense flavours, beautifully structured, with a delicate and lingering perfume. A beauty with a full body, dry and packed with flavour: dark fruit, herbs, and sage. Aged for around a year in oak barrels. 13.5%
